

European Customers tend to work with Euro Pallets



1. TRY AND MAXIMISE YOUR **CASES PER PALLET**




To reduce your shipment cost per kilo you need to maximise cases/pallet Make sure its robust so as to minimise potential for damage Make sure its workable between Standard and Euro Pallets

Export Approval

You may need Export

contains meat products


Trucks may need to be sealed at point of Dispatch by DAFM


DAFM

Product may require additional supervision based on volume being exported.

2. CMR | YOUR KEY DOCUMENT FOR EXPORTING WITHIN THE EU







Standardized document for cross-border transport of cargo by road, based on UN recommendations for uniform international rules and in force in the European Union. CMR stands for 'Convention relative au contract de transport international de Merchandises par route,' the French name for the convention that governs its definitions and application.

Paperwork your Customer needs to get the product you are exporting through their Customs?

Check with your customers if there is any specific certification: required of their ingredients / products such as Halal, Kosher

For Example- meat ingredients for products destined for Saudi Arabia or Tunisia, the raw meat coming into the

plant must be accompanied by a Movement Cert from the DAFM. This Certifies that the meat is suitable for

DAFM & IEA

Check the Certification requirements for your product with your local DAFM for the Specific Country you are looking to export to

For example—Meat or Dairy
Ingredients may need to be purchased
from approved vendors for Shipment
to that specific country, raw materials
would have to be accompanied by Preexport Health Certs for that country
before being processed.
